Declaration of Compliance

REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006

To Whom It May Concern,

Teledyne FLIR OEM has conducted an evaluation of the Boson Camera Cores (all part numbers) per REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 and declares to the best of our knowledge, that the articles do not contain the substances listed in the following sections of this directive, except for the possible presence of lead as allowable under RoHS exceptions 7a, or 7c-i.

- **As per the latest update on February 4, 2026, an additional two hazardous chemicals have been added to the SVHC list. That brings the total up to 253 substances.**
 - Boson camera cores do not contain any of the substances, in a concentration greater than 0.1% by weight, as described in Article 67, including Annex XIV and Annex XVII.

Compliance of the Boson cores is based on supplier declarations and Teledyne FLIR OEM Engineering analysis. Teledyne FLIR OEM does not warrant the accuracy of the supplier statements but will use our best efforts to ensure the credibility of the documentation received.

Note that this declaration covers the Boson cores considering the ruling of the European Court of Justice (ECJ) concerning the definition of an article for REACH SVHCs. On September 10, 2015, the ECJ ruled that each of the articles incorporated as a component of a complex product is covered by the relevant duties to notify and provide information when they contain a substance of very high concern in a concentration above 0.1% of their mass. Therefore, we declare that no REACH SVHCs in any component of these complex articles exceed 0.1% w/w of the component.
